



For this month's posting of the Traveling Fork, let's talk about the BODRUM MEDITERRANEAN KITCHEN. It can be found at 5907 Roosevelt Blvd, Unit 200, just north of NAS JAX on highway 17–on the right side if you are going north.

Its slogan is "Where Florida Meets the Flavors of the Aegean". Its large menu features fresh daily soup, Ten appetizers, a Kids' Menu, Salads, Sandwiches, Bowls, Platters, Greek Pizzas, Fresh Sides Extras, and Desserts.

Interestingly, the menu contains both Greek and Turkish dishes. The history of the Greeks and Turks doesn't reflect a lot of love between the two nationalities. However, this little restaurant combines the best of both in my opinion. We have taken meals twice there and have been delighted both times.

We (a party of six) sampled the Falafel, Spicy Hummus, Spanokopita, Tzatziki, a large Appetizer Sampler, Moussaka, Lamb Saute, and Lamb Gyro Bowl. Each dish was well prepared and was very tasty.

The prices are very reasonable and this small restaurant is very tastefully decorated, clean, and the service is great! If you like Mediterranian food, check this place out—you won't be disappointed.
